BLESSING OF THE LIGHT

PSALM 33

REJOICE in the Lord, O ye righteous : for it becometh well the just to be thankful.

Praise the Lord with harp : sing praises unto him with the lute, and instrument of ten strings.

Sing unto the Lord a new song : sing praises lustily unto him with a good courage.

For the word of the Lord is true : and all his works are faithful.

He loveth righteousness and judgement : the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord.

By the word of the Lord were the heavens made : and all the hosts of them by the breath of his mouth.

He gathereth the waters of the sea together, as it were upon an heap : and layeth up the deep, as in a treasure-house.

Let all the earth fear the Lord : stand in awe of him, all ye that dwell in the world.

For he spake, and it was done : he commanded, and it stood fast.

The Lord bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought : and maketh the devices of the people to be of none effect, and casteth out the counsels of princes.

The counsel of the Lord shall endure for ever : and the thoughts of his heart from generation to generation.

Blessed are the people, whose God is the Lord Jehovah : and blessed are the folk, that he hath chosen to him to be his inheritance.

The Lord looked down from heaven, and beheld all the children of men : from the habitation of his dwelling he considereth all them that dwell on the earth.

He fashioneth all the hearts of them : and understandeth all their works.

 fear him : and delivereth them.
 O taste, and see, how gracious the Lord is : blessed is
 the man that trusteth in him.
 O fear the Lord, ye that are his saints : for they that fear
 him lack nothing.
 The lions do lack, and suffer hunger : but they who seek
 the Lord shall want no manner of thing that is good.
 Come, ye children, and hearken unto me : I will teach
 you the fear of the Lord.
 What man is he that lusteth to live : and would fain see
 good days?
 Keep thy tongue from evil : and thy lips, that they speak
 no guile.
 Eschew evil, and do good : seek peace, and ensue it.
 The eyes of the Lord are over the righteous : and his
 ears are open unto their prayers.
 The countenance of the Lord is against them that do
 evil : to root out the remembrance of them from the
 earth.
 The righteous cry, and the Lord heareth them : and
 delivereth them out of all their troubles.
 The Lord is nigh unto them that are of a contrite heart :
 and will save such as be of an humble spirit.
 Great are the troubles of the righteous : but the Lord
 delivereth him out of all.
 He keepeth all his bones : so that not one of them is
 broken.
 But misfortune shall slay the ungodly : and they that
 hate the righteous shall be desolate.
 The Lord delivereth the souls of his servants : and all
 they that put their trust in him shall not be destitute.
