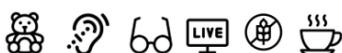

PSALM 116

I AM well pleased : that the Lord hath heard the voice

call upon him as long as I live.
The snares of death compassed me round about : and
the pains of hell gat hold upon me.
I shall find trouble and heaviness, and I will call upon
the Name of the Lord : O Lord, I beseech thee,
deliver my soul.

merciful.
